Status Update: Resilience Fund Grants

Waymakers received a \$25,000 grant from the OC Community Resilience Fund. The money will support Waymakers' general services as they continue providing essential resources on the frontlines of COVID-19, including counseling, therapy, conflict resolution, support services for victims of crime including human trafficking and sexual assault, prevention and education programs and basic needs of vulnerable clients.

With \$1.9M awarded to 87 nonprofits in its third round of grants, the [OC Community Resilience Fund](#) has now awarded a total of \$4.18 million to 162 nonprofits, community health clinics and support for individuals. The Orange County Community Foundation (OCCF), St. Joseph Community Partnership Fund, Charitable Ventures and regional funding partners launched the OC Community Resilience Fund in March.
