24-hour Giving Day Reaps Nearly \$180,000 for Foundation

The **Orange County Community Foundation** managed to raise **\$179,519 in a 24-hour Giving Day for 11 nonprofits** throughout the county that offer programs and services to help remove barriers to employment. About 455 donors participated.

The Newport Beach organization called the campaign “**The Future is Working.**” Organizers said the initial fundraising goal was \$90,000.

“The Future is Working is not only a campaign theme, but a resounding declaration in support of the nonprofits that are bolstering equitable opportunities for Orange County’s workforce,” said Shelley Hoss, president and chief executive of the Orange County Community Foundation in a statement. “We are grateful to our community for stepping up today to support this Giving Day and invest in the long-term health and vitality of our region.”

This is not the first Giving Day held by the organization, with the first dating back to 20
