

Status Update: Fundraiser

The fourth annual Empowering Possibilities, a Giving Day for OC neighbors with disabilities, will be held May 20.

The 24-hour virtual event is looking to raise \$100,000. Last year's Empowering Possibilities Giving Day raised \$77,387 from 325 donors.

The 10 participating nonprofits include Blind Children's Learning Center of OC, Down Syndrome Association of OC, Family Support Network, Hope Center for the Arts, Project Independence, Special Olympics Southern California, Speech and Language Development Center, Dayle MacIntosh Center, UCP of Orange County and Vocational Visions.

All of the participating nonprofits had to cancel all in-person fundraising events and meetings in 2020 because of the ongoing pandemic.

This Empowering Possibilities Giving Day has raised more than \$10 million for Orange County nonprofits.
